<u>COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM (CSP)</u> ACTIVITES FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2023

1. <u>CELEBRATED SPECIAL CHILDREN'S DAY AT KARSAZ SPECIAL</u> <u>CHILDREN'S SCHOOL</u>

The Community Support Program (CSP) successfully celebrated "Special Children's Day" on 5th December 2023 at Karsaz Special Children's School. Where our students organized multiple engaging activities, distributed goodies, set up stalls, and facilitated various gaming activities. Students who arranged goodies bags for children's and set up stalls were awarded with 5 CSP hours.









2. AWARENESS SESSION ON THALASSEMIA BY AMTF:

The Community Support Program successfully conducted an insightful session on 8th December 2023 at Al-Beruni Auditorium.

- a. Thalassemia is an inherited blood disorder that affects the body's ability to produce hemoglobin and red blood cells. With an increase in the number of Thalassemia victims in Pakistan and the aim of building Thalassemia awareness in our youth.
- b. The guest of our awareness session was *Dr. Asim Qidwai* He is the founder and CEO of Afzaal Memorial Thalassemia Foundation (AMTF) and Hemoglobin disorder specialist. Dr. Qidwai also works as Philanthropist, Social worker, Health care & policy Management. He has developed future vision AMTF, DMC, JSW, in Sindh, Sundus Foundation in Punjab, and Vonhar Hospital KalaarKar.
- c. In this session 300+ students participated and learned what Thalassemia disease is and how it can thalassemia be cured and what are the precautions of thalassemia.







3. ANTI-CORRUPTIONAWARENESS SEMINAR:

The Student Support Center (SSC) successfully conducted an insightful session on 11th December 2023 at Al-Beruni Auditorium. This awareness session was organized by CBS and students were awarded 3 CSP hours for this session.

In this, the guest speakers who are well experienced and knowledgeable had further concreted the understanding and new happenings related to digital marketing as well as sustainable development in Pakistan.
