ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2023

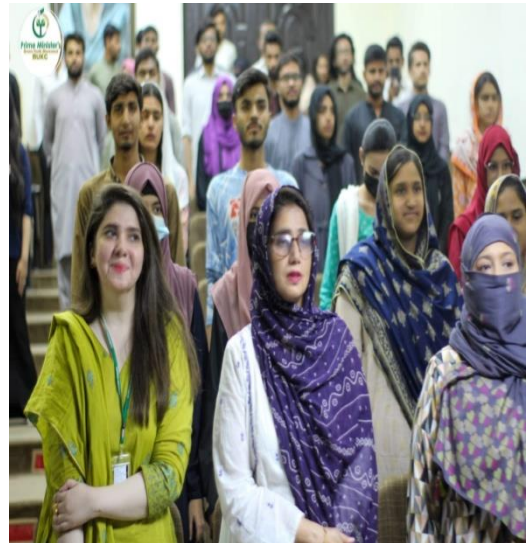
1. BLOOD DONATION DRIVE WITH AFZAL MEMORIAL THALASSEMIA FOUNDATION (AMTF):
