COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM (CSP) ACTIVITES FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2023

1. <u>A SEMINAR ON BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES IN</u> LIGHT OF SEERAT:

A successful completion of a seminar on "Business & Professional Practices In Light Of Seerat" organized by Business Studies Department in collaboration with The Community Support Program which was held on 6th October 2023 at Al- Beruni Auditorium for which students were given 3 CSP hours for this informative session.

The program consisted of two segments. In the initial part, students from diverse departments delivered speeches, and subsequently, our esteemed guest speakers shared their insights during the second part.

2. <u>A SEMINAR ON RESQ TO THE RESCUE: BASIC FIRST AID</u> SESSION

The Community Support Program successfully conducted an enlightening session on "RESQ to the rescue, Basic First-Aid Session" in collaboration with RESQ team this seminar was held on 10th October 2023 at Al- Beruni Auditorium for which students were given 3 CSP hours for this informative session.

The session encompassed the following agenda:

- a. Basic Life Support (comprising CPR, rescue breaths, and the recovery position).
- b. Choking incidents (covering Adult and Infant choking scenarios, as well as the Heimlich maneuver).
- c. Management of bleeding (including the use of bandages and tourniquets).
- d. Dealing with fractures (involving the application of splints and triangular bandages).

The first aid session equipped our students with essential life-saving skills and knowledge, empowering them to respond effectively to emergencies and potentially save lives.







3. A SEMINAR ON NAAT/SPEECH COMPETITION

The enlightening session on "Naat/Speech Competition" this seminar was organized by the department of Islamic Studies. The event was organized by the EMC Club, with students from the debating club delivering speeches and members of the music club reciting Naat.

This was held on October 16, 2023, at Al-Beruni Auditorium, and students were given 3 CSP hours for their participation.







4. PINK RIBBON YOUTH PROGRAMME 2023 – BREAST CANCER AWARENESS SEMINAR:

The Community Support Program successfully conducted an enlightening session on "Pink Ribbon Youth Programme 2023- Breast Cancer Awareness Seminar" in collaboration with the Higher Education Commission, Pink Ribbon Pakistan to raise awareness of Breast Cancer.
