COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM (CSP) ACTIVITES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2024

1. "AI-QUDS TALBA" CONFERENCE:

Talba Conference" - Solidarity for Palestine in collaboration with the Dar e Khidmat Foundation. This event was held on 1st of January 2024 at Al-Beruni Auditorium. This conference was not just gathering students or faculty members, it was an invitation for people to come together and talk about the problems that how the Palestinians is dealing with. We organized this conference in solidarity with Palestine. The event aimed to make more people aware of the challenges faced by Palestine. By discussing these issues openly, we hoped to bring attention to the situation and promote understanding. Also we wanted to create a space where people could talk openly about the problems and find common ground. By fostering dialogue, we aimed to build bridges and find solutions that benefited everyone involved. The ultimate goal was to contribute to positive change for Palestine.



2. **BOOK DONATION DRIVE:**

The Community Support Program arranged a "Book Donation Drive 2024" into two phases and the CSP has achieved success in the first phase of its book donation drive. The initiative focused on collecting a variety of books, including course materials and novels. Focus was more on collecting course books of BUKC. The activity was held from January 22nd to January 26th, 2024, during the last week of final exams. In the second phase, the collected books will be distributed by selling them at a low cost to financially needy students. This strategic approach aims to make educational resources more accessible to students, fostering a culture of learning and community support. The generous act of donating books is scheduled to take place during the first week of the upcoming semester "Spring 2024", benefiting students as they start their new academic journey. The students who contributed to the book donation drive were acknowledged with 3 CSP hours, regardless of whether they donated a single book or multiple books.









3. OPEN HOUSE EVENT OF SSC BUKC:

The Student Support Center (SSC) organized the **Open House Event 2024** on **24**th **January 2024**, with its **Team Members** in the main Foyer (Quaid Block).

The event featured various desk setups representing each department within the SSC, including **Student Facilitation**, **The Community Support Program**, **Numerous Students' Clubs**, **Alumni Affairs**, and **Placement Matters**.

The purpose was to assist students with their queries and concerns, particularly for those who may not be familiar with these departments and domains. Instead of students wandering around without their issues being addressed, the Open House aimed to provide a centralized and accessible platform for problem resolution.
