1. ANTI HARRASEMENT SESSION BY ENGR ERUM SHAFIQ








3. <u>DONATION DRIVE FOR EARTHQUAKE EFFECTED PEOPLE TURKEY AT BUKC</u>

- d. You all are invited to attend this worthwhile seminar and dine with CSP Club at Al Beruni Auditorium on Thursday, 2nd April 2023.







3. WORLD THALASSEMIA DAY


