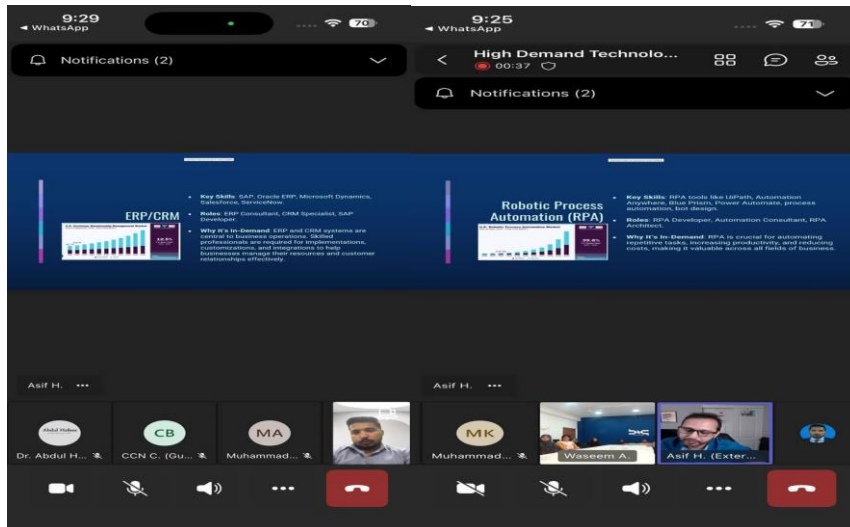

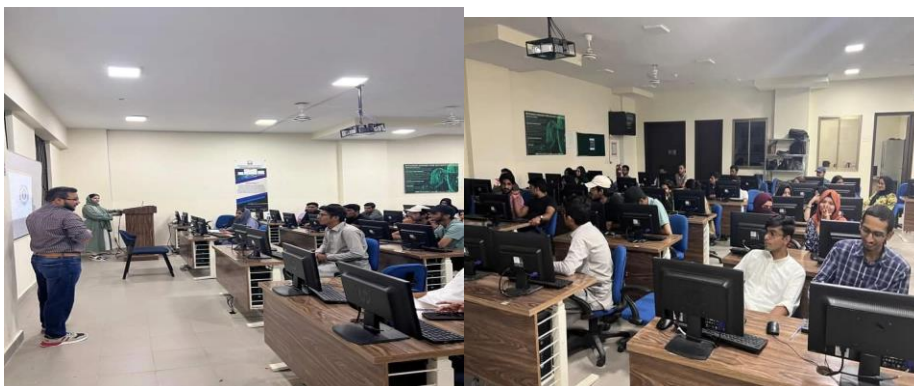


Data driven session
