30- Does your university have a student union?

Yes, Bahria University has structures equivalent to a student union, including various student societies and clubs that represent student interests and facilitate engagement in campus activities. Evidence of these societies and clubs is attached below,

DEFINITIONS

Club: A student-led co-curricular body organized around a broad interest area such as wellbeing, arts, culture, hobbies, creative expression, community service, or campus life primarily intended to increase participation, soft skills, and positive student experience.

Society: A student-led body organized around an academic, professional, or structured thematic domain such as data science, law, public health, finance, or technical innovation typically requiring deeper discipline-linked engagement, structured outputs, professional networking, and contribution to employability and innovation indicators.

Bahria University Vision and Mission

Vision: To become a knowledge and creativity driven international university that contributes towards the development of society.

Mission: To ensure academic excellence through the deliverance of quality education and applied research in a collegiate environment having strong linkages with industry and international community to meet the social challenges.

Purpose of Clubs and Societies at BU

Student Clubs and Societies translate the University's vision and mission into campus life by creating platforms where students build creativity, leadership, civic responsibility, professional competence, research and innovation exposure, and industry and international linkages. The Clubs and Societies ecosystem shall therefore be organized as a University-wide system that is structured, auditable, inclusive within campus norms, and aligned with academic excellence and ethical conduct.

Alignment Rule: BU Vision/Mission and Club/Society Vision/Mission

Each club and society shall maintain a concise vision and mission statement that aligns with the BU vision of becoming a knowledge and creativity driven international university, and BU's mission of delivering quality education and applied research with strong industry and international linkages. Accordingly, every club and society must demonstrate at least one of the following alignment pathways in its annual plan:

(i) student learning and skills development; (ii) applied innovation and problem-solving; (iii) community engagement addressing social challenges; (iv) industry exposure and employability; and/or (v) international visibility and collaboration. The SSC and DSA BUHO will review alignment at the time of registration/renewal and during annual performance evaluation.
