

## World Hepatitis Day - Awareness and Scientific Programme held at the BUHSCK

On July 30, 2025, the Department of Medicine at BUHSCK, in collaboration with the Pakistan Society of Physicians (Sindh Region), organized a comprehensive World Hepatitis Day program themed "*Tet's Break the Silence Before It Breaks Us*" Featuring scientific presentations, a panel discussion, and a poster competition. The initiative aimed to raise public awareness and address the challenges of viral hepatitis. Major General (R) Shehla M. Baqai HI(M), Dean HS and Principal BUMC, inaugurated the event by underscoring the urgency of early diagnosis and coordinated clinical action. The event was attended by BUHSCK faculty, medical students, and healthcare professionals.

The program included an esteemed keynote scientific session by Prof. Dr. Wasim Jafri on "From Discovery to Elimination of Hepatitis B & C," complemented by expert lectures from Dr. Nazish Butt on hepatitis C guidelines and Prof. Dr. Sajid Abbas Jaffri on liver cirrhosis.



The session concluded with an insightful panel discussion on "Clinical Challenges in Hepatitis Management" featuring distinguished experts: Prof. Dr. Wasim Jafri (Renowned Gastroenterologist; Former Chair, AKUH), Prof. Dr. Shehla M. Baqai HI(M) (Women's Health Advisor; Dean & Principal, BUHS-CK), Prof. Dr. Jameel Ahmed (Dean, Baqai Medical University), Prof. Dr. Badar Faiyaz Zuberi (Former Dean & Chair of Medicine, DUHS), Prof. Dr. Qaiser Jamal (HoD Medicine & Allied, ASH/KMU), Prof. Dr. Amanullah Abbasi (Chair of Medicine, DUHS), and Brig. (R) Prof. Dr. Pervaiz Asghar (Consultant, BUHS-CK). The panel underscored the urgent need for enhanced screening programs, improved patient follow-up systems, and stronger public health initiatives to curb the growing burden of hepatitis in Pakistan.
