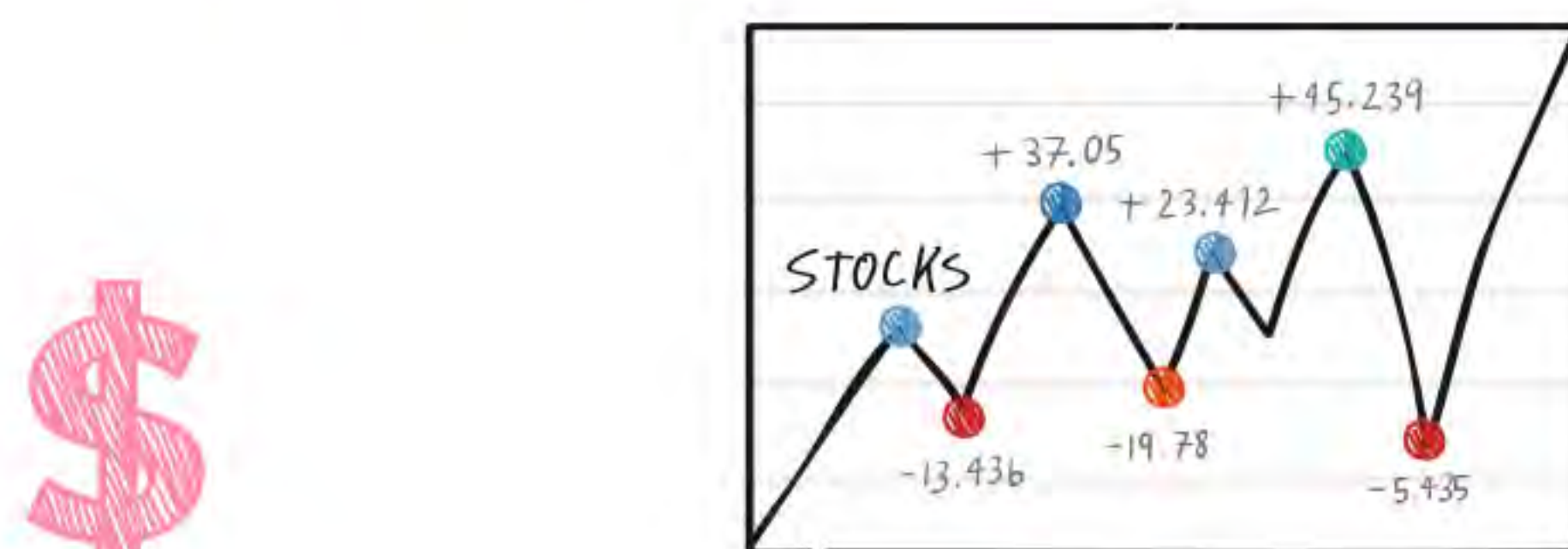
## DISCUSSION ON STRATEGIES TO STRENGTHEN AND OPERATIONALIZE

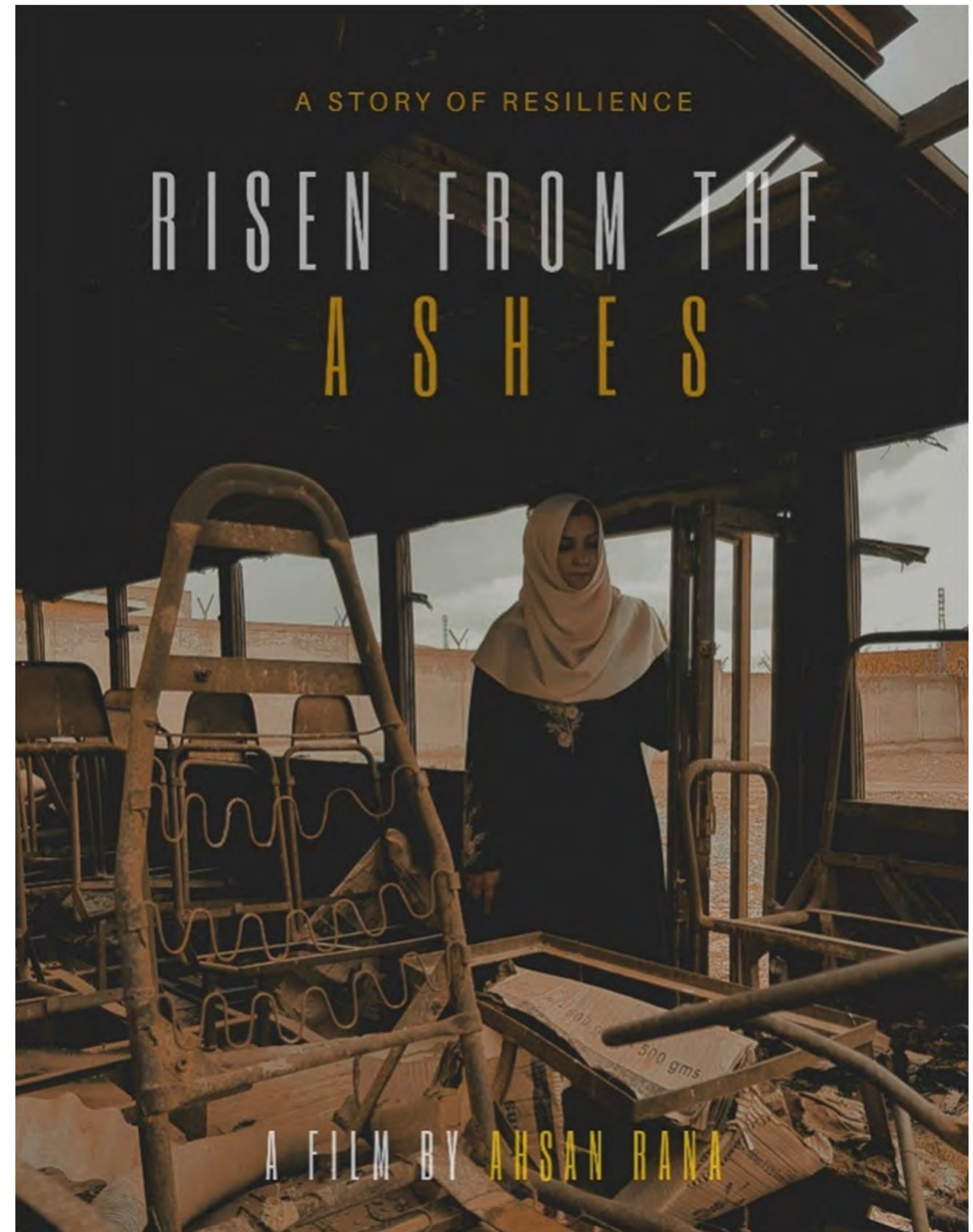




## 1st PRIZE FOR MAKING BEST DOCUMENTARY AT NATIONAL PURAZM AWARDS

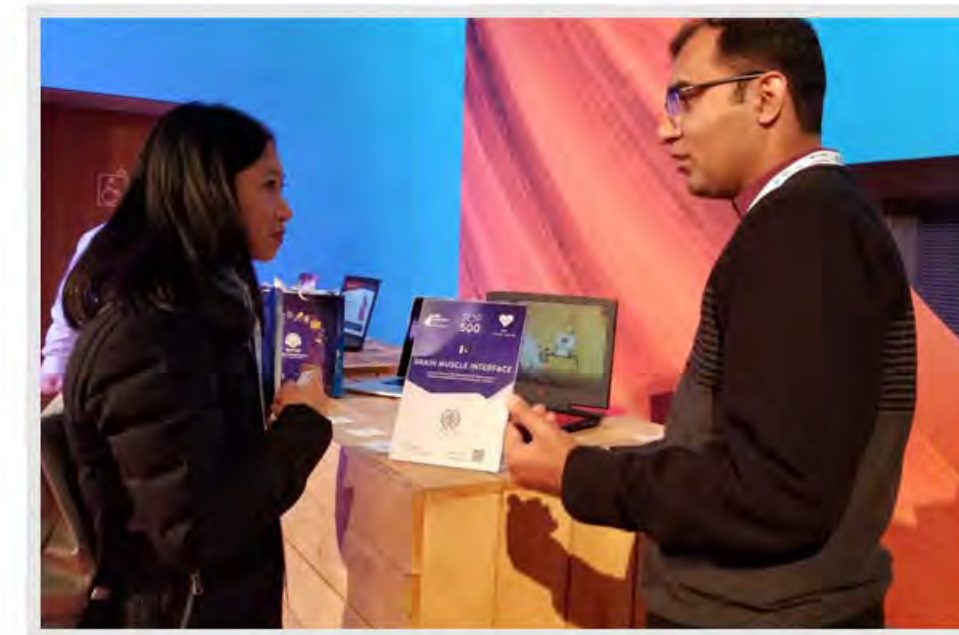

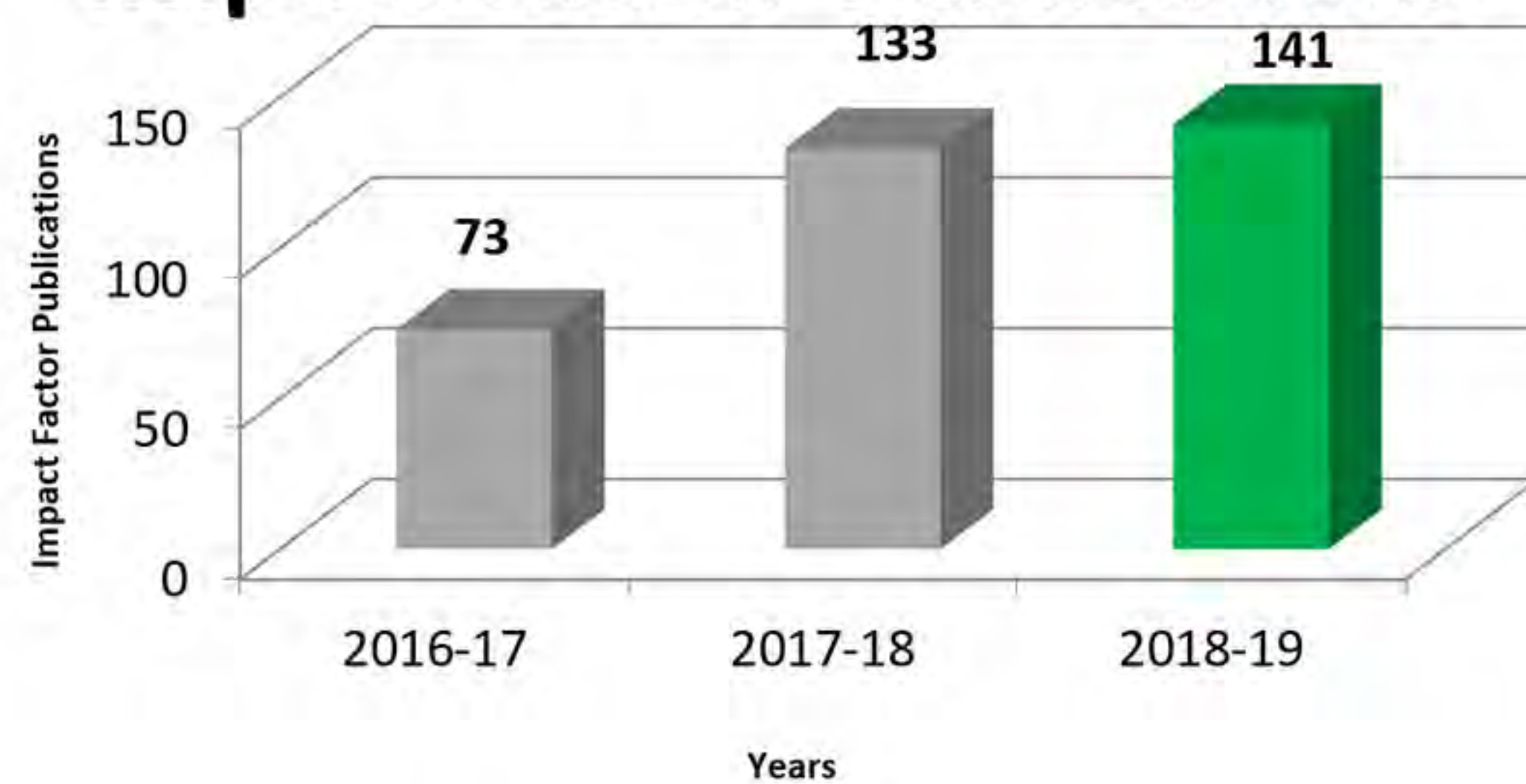
## Increasing Trend in the Major Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) of Research at Bahria University

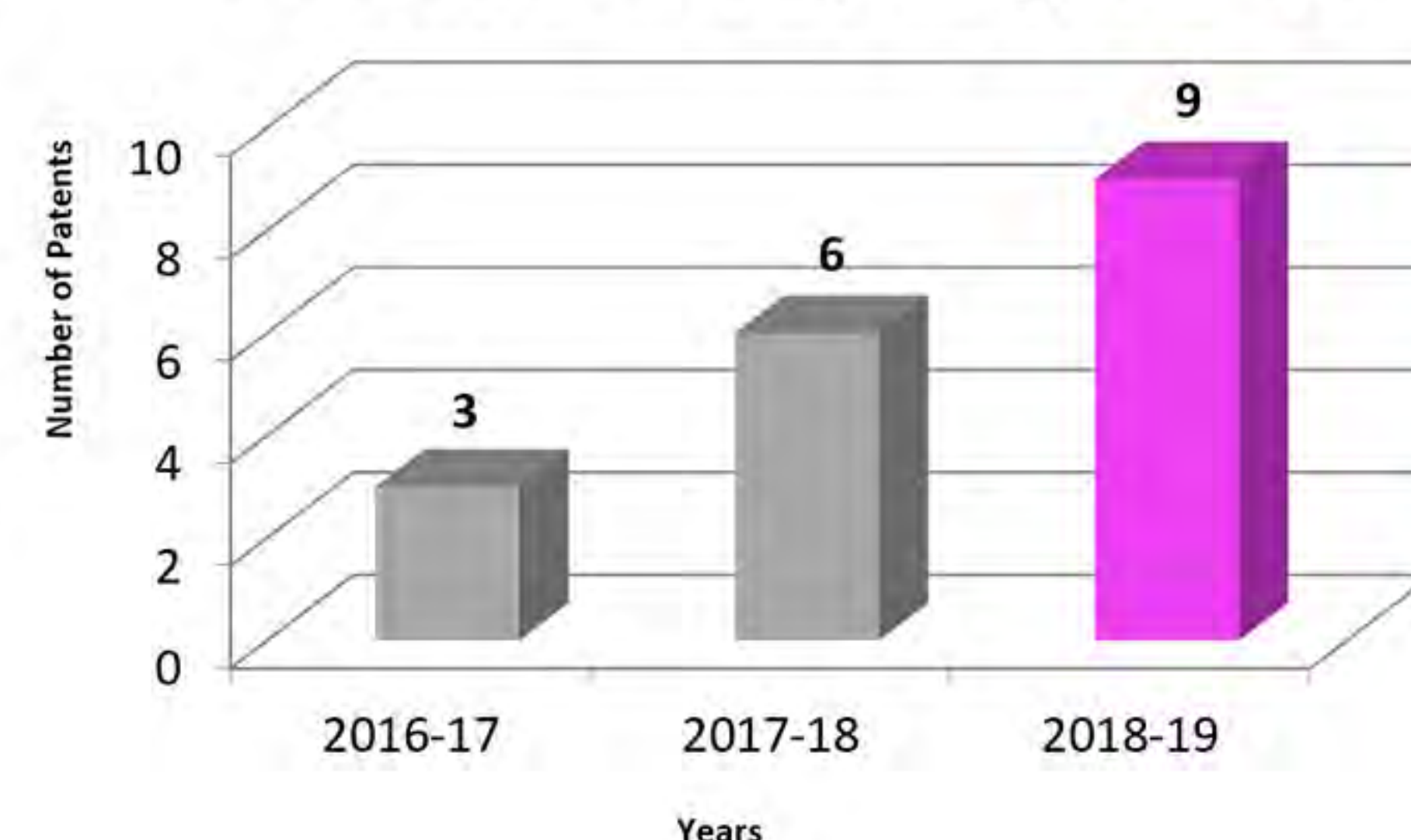

In the past few years, after dedicated focus on research, there has been an increase in the investment, impact factor publications, travel grants from HEC and patents registration rate.

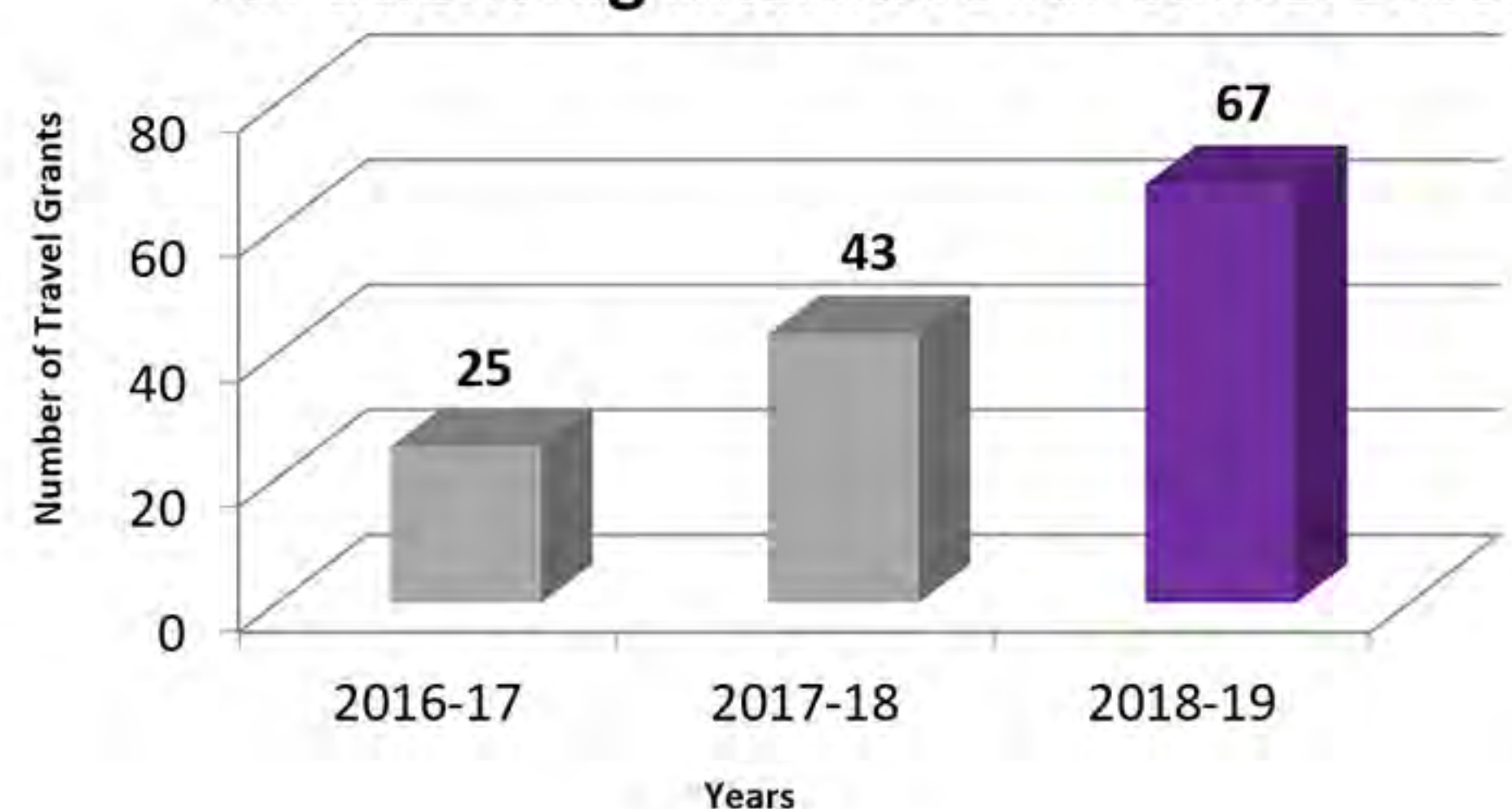
### Impact Factor Publications



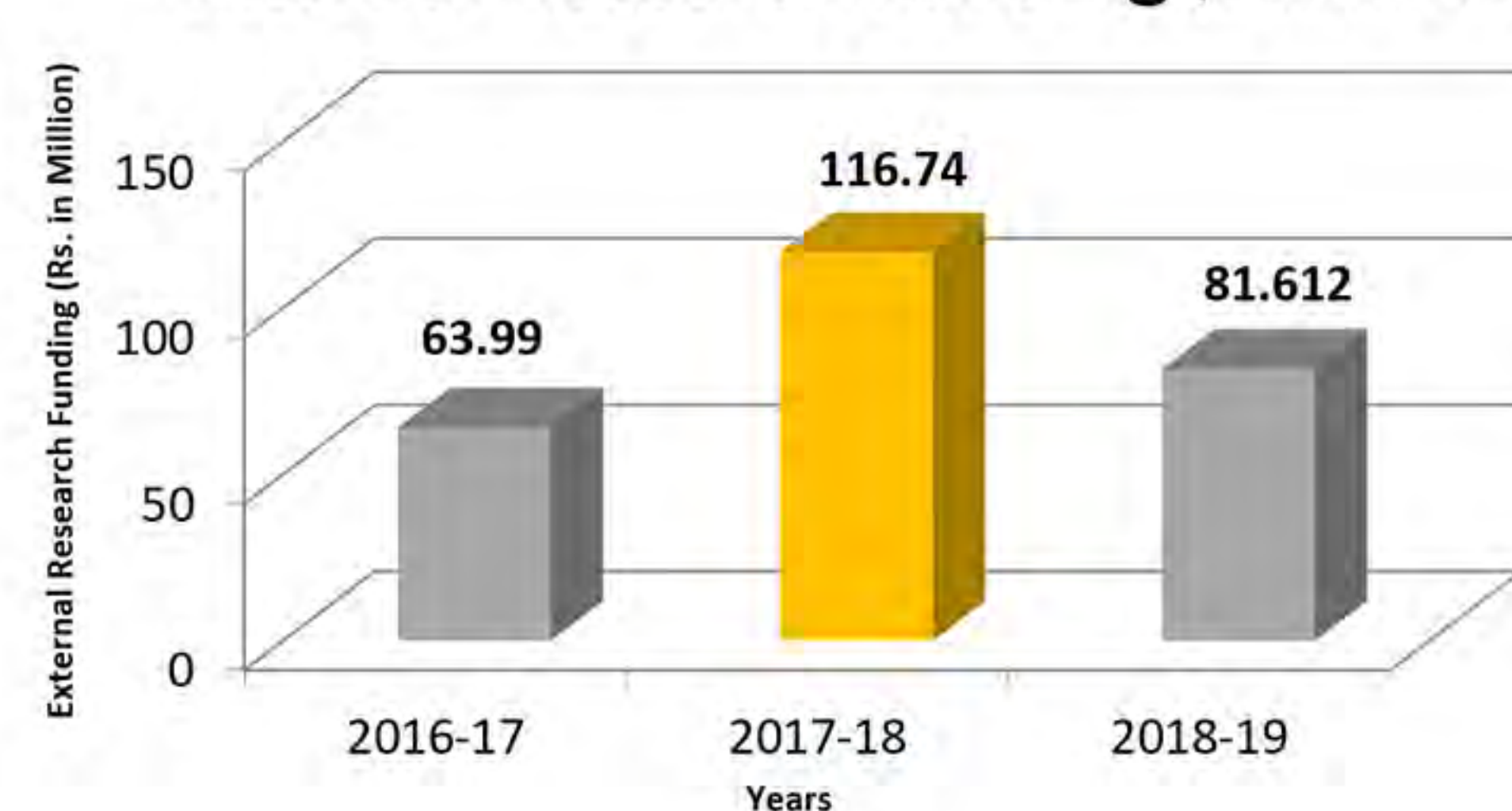
### Patents Filed / Registered



### Travel Grants from HEC for attending International Conferences

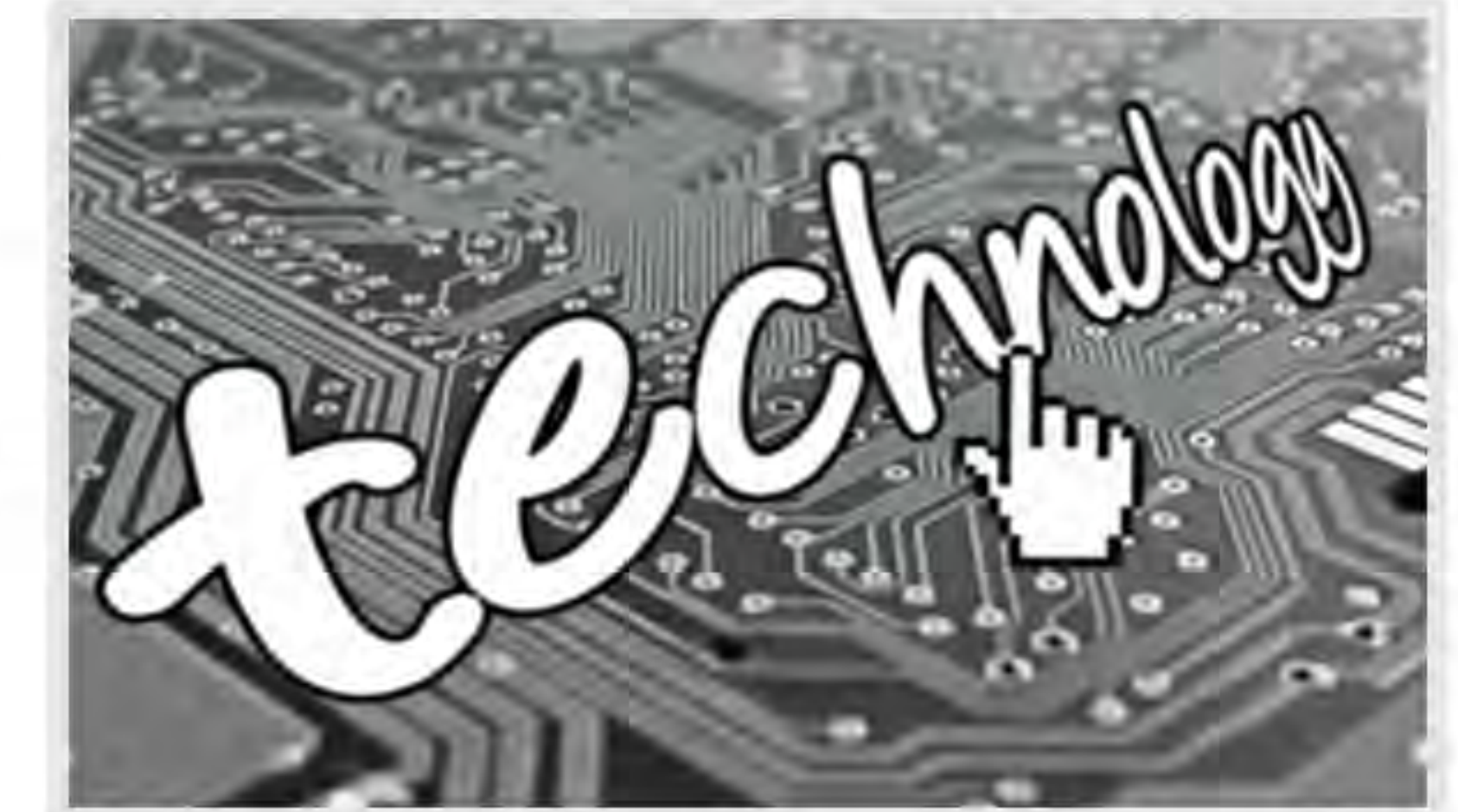

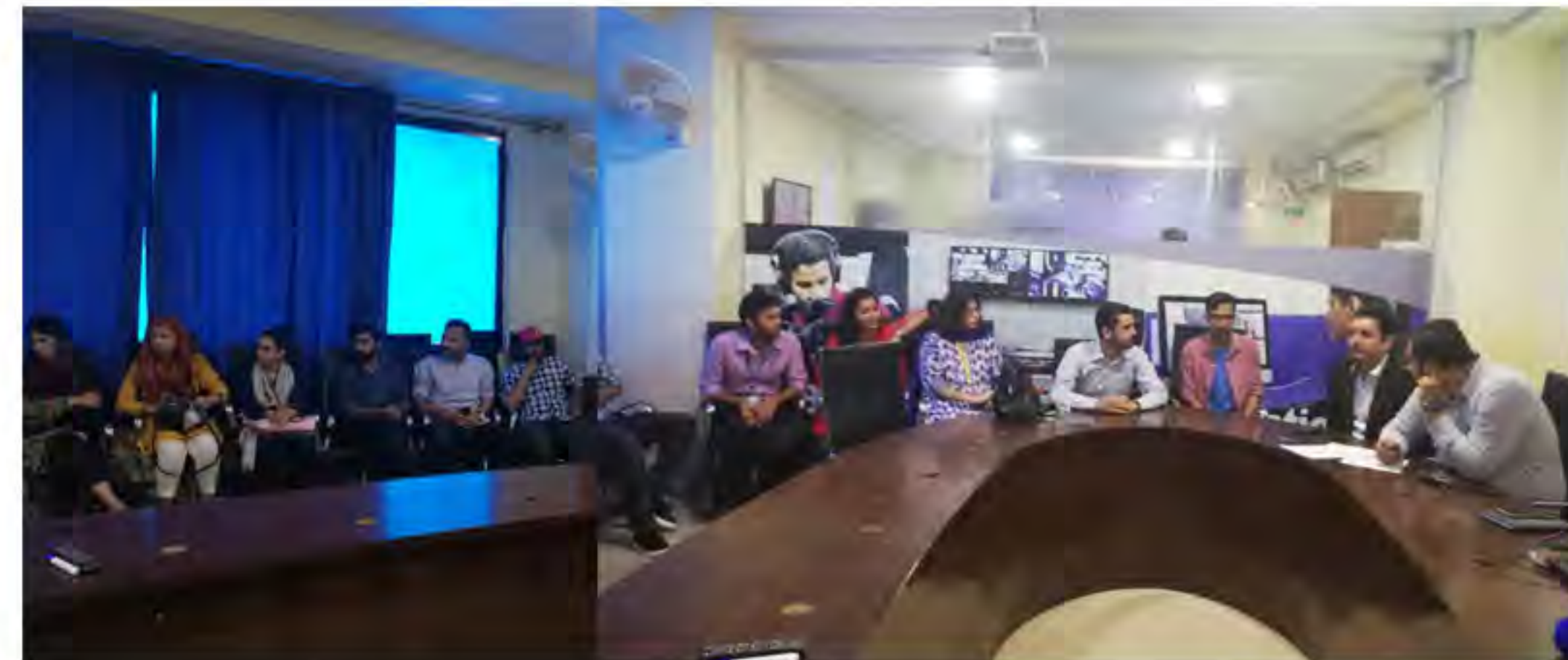

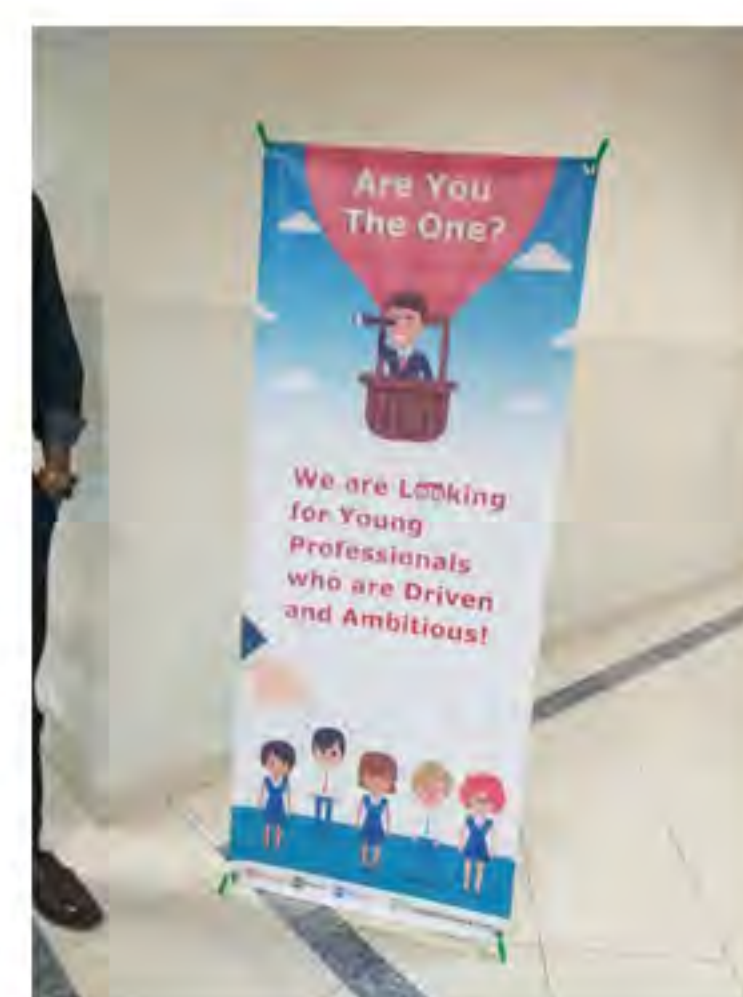
