Activities for Environmental Sustainability

Plantation: CSP club immensely focuses on Plantation activities as Pakistan has only 5 percent of forested area as opposed to the internationally established standard of 25 percent. BU has been an

active member of the Prime Minister's Clean & Green Initiative since 2018. The same regularly collaborates with NGOs, public & private sector organizations and even undertakes independent initiatives.





Waste Disposal & Counter Pollution: Anti - Littering Drives for the removal of wastage & pollution re regular features for BU's community support program for emphasizing on the maintenance of sustainability of our environment. Students/Volunteers are equipped with gloves, large bags & determination to save the environment. Public parks are often the main focus for such initiatives.



Awareness & Education: Awareness and education help individuals and communities comprehend the significance of environmental sustainability. An informed community know of thel challenges faced by Pakistan, such as pollution, deforestation etc., they are more likely to take actions to protect the environment.
